Florida Podiatric Medical Association invites you to attend the annual Science & Management Symposium (SAM) taking place January 15 to 19, 2020 at Disney's Coronado Springs Resort in Lake Buena Vista, Florida.

FPMA's educational mission is to promote continuing education in podiatric medicine, podiatric surgery, and practice management through workshops and seminars. Our commitment is to increase knowledge by offering every registrant the educational assistance needed to improve care for their patients and be successful in practice by promoting the benefits of scientific advancement in the treatment, prevention, and alleviation of podiatric ailments.

The intended audience of the SAM 2020 conference is Doctors of Podiatric Medicine and Podiatric Residents.

SAM Physician Registration includes access to all lectures and the Exhibit Hall, as well as breakfast, lunch, and AM/PM breaks for designated days throughout the conference. Physicians must be registered for the entire program to attend any portion of the program.

A new one-hour **Human Trafficking** course, recently implemented by the Florida Legislature, will also be offered. This is a one-time requirement licensees must complete before January 1, 2021.

CECH at SAM

FPMA is approved by the Council on Podiatric Medical Education (CPME) as a provider of continuing education in podiatric medicine. Continuing Education Contact Hours (CECH) will be awarded to SAM 2020 physician attendees and total possible CECH will be posted on the SAM Conference website at fpmasamconference.com once the SAM 2020 schedule is finalized and approved.

CECH functions are for registered attendees only. Scanning badges and a scanning schedule will be provided to each SAM 2020 physician attendee when they check in at the SAM 2020 registration desk. CECH credits are based on attendance of educational sessions; sessions specified as "Non-CECH" are not included in compiling CECH credits. CECH credits are calculated hour-per-hour based on courses attended.

SAM 2020 physician attendees will receive a link to the SAM 2020 on-line conference evaluation within two weeks of the conclusion of the conference, pending all conference fees being paid and attendance verified by FPMA. Once the on-line conference evaluation is completed, a Certificate of Attendance based on CECH earned will be available for printing/downloading.

The current biennium runs from April 1, 2018 - March 31, 2020. As such, current Florida podiatric licenses will expire at midnight, Eastern Time, on March 31, 2020. Continuing education contact hours (CECH) will be submitted to CE Broker on behalf of SAM 2020 attendees who are currently licensed in the state of Florida once the conference is over and all CECH are verified. Florida licensees can access their CECH information for the current biennium by logging in to their CE Broker account at cebroker.com. SAM 2020 attendees who are NOT licensed in the state of Florida will receive a Certificate of Attendance once the conference concludes, which will provide a listing of all the CECH they earned.
