The Florida Podiatric Medical Association (FPMA) is pleased to announce the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Residents Forum taking place at the FPMA Science & Management Symposium (SAM 2022) on Friday, January 28, 2022 from 1:30 - 3:30 p.m.

Like previous years, FPMA is requesting engaging cases to be presented in a PowerPoint format with a strict 7.5-minute time limit. We will award the top five presenters with winnings of \$500 (1<sup>st</sup> place), \$400 (2<sup>nd</sup> place), \$300 (3<sup>rd</sup> place), \$200 (4<sup>th</sup> place), or \$100 (5<sup>th</sup> place). The top 5 winners will be announced, and the 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will be asked to present, on Saturday, January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Presentations will be scored based on:

- a) Quality of the oral presentation
- b) Rationale for procedure/fixation employed
- c) Lessons learned from the success/failure of the surgery
- d) Strict adherence to the 7.5-minute time limit

**Residents must be FPMA/APMA members to participate. No more than one resident per residency program allowed to present on first round of applications. If spots remain open, correspondence will be sent and cases accepted on first come, first serve basis.**
