Case Presentation Deadline for participation:

The Florida Podiatric Medical Association (FPMA) is pleased to announce the 19th Annual Residents Forum taking place at the FPMA Science & Management Symposium (SAM 2023) on **Friday, February 3, 2023 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.**

As in previous years, FPMA is requesting engaging cases to be presented in a PowerPoint format with a strict 7.5-minute time limit. We will award the top three presenters with winnings of \$500 (1st place), \$400 (2nd place), and \$300 (3rd place). The top winners will be announced, and the 1st place winner will be asked to present, on **Saturday, February 4, 2023** at 2:00 p.m. in the main lecture hall.

Presentations will be scored based on:

- a) Quality of the oral presentation
- b) Rationale for procedure/fixation employed
- c) Lessons learned from the success/failure of the surgery
- d) Strict adherence to the 7.5-minute time limit

Residents must be FPMA/APMA members to participate. No more than one resident per residency program will be allowed to present on the first round of applications. If spots remain open, correspondence will be sent and cases accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
